**The state agency investigating the
2006 Queens Power Outage says:**

- There's no way to know how badly the Western Queens electrical network was damaged until the "summer of 2007 and beyond."
- That could mean more Queens power problems this summer.
- Unless hearings show Con Ed management spent past money "imprudently," **we will have to pay** for the outage repairs with rate increases!

- Con Ed management will soon be asking for regular rate increases (current rates expire at the end of this year).
- Con Ed management also wants to make customers pay for outage repairs by preventing "prudence hearings" on its neglect of our electrical network.
- **Get ready to speak out:** Western Queens communities are still owed millions of dollars from last year's damages and losses! We should not pay one penny more!! Let Con Ed management and stockholders foot the bill!
